IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT TICKETS

You will purchase tickets on Eventbrite through ASBC. In order to attend the performance, you must present an official Kennedy Center ticket. You will have three opportunities to pick up your official Kennedy Center tickets: (1) At ASBC after all worship services on January 27 and January 28; (2) At ASBC after all worship services on February 3 and February 4; (3) At the Kennedy Center starting Tuesday, February 6 up until Showtime. A Kennedy Center envelope will be given to you with your official Kennedy Center tickets.

WHEN, WHERE & HOW TO PICK UP OFFICIAL KENNEDY CENTER TICKETS

Saturday January 27th and Sunday January 28th after all worship services, in 301 S. Alfred Street building, lower level (Multipurpose Room on Saturday, Fellowship Hall on Sunday). Present the printout of your Eventbrite ticket with the QR code or bring it up on your phone. A Kennedy Center envelope with your official Kennedy Center tickets will be given to you. *Eventbrite tickets purchased AFTER Tuesday, January 23 will NOT be available for pick-up on the first weekend (Jan 27/28)*.

Saturday February 3rd and Sunday February 4th after all worship services, in 301 S. Alfred Street building, lower level (Multipurpose Room on Saturday, Fellowship Hall on Sunday). Present the printout of your Eventbrite ticket with the QR code or bring it up on your phone. A Kennedy Center envelope with your official Kennedy Center tickets will be given to you.

Tuesday February 6th up until SHOWTIME, Thursday, February 8, Kennedy Center Main Box Office in the Hall of State. Give the box office your first and last name. Your association with ASBC is not relevant to them. You do NOT need to show the Eventbrite printout. You will receive a Kennedy Center envelope with your official Kennedy Center tickets.

KENNEDY CENTER WILL CALL TICKET PICKUP

If you pick up your tickets at the Kennedy Center, you are strongly encouraged to pick up your tickets EARLY and prior to Showtime to avoid long lines and delays. A Kennedy Center envelope will be given to you at Will Call containing all of the tickets that you purchased via Eventbrite. For example, if you purchased 2 Eventbrite tickets and then returned to the ASBC church website to purchase 2 additional Eventbrite tickets, your Kennedy Center envelope will contain all 4 Kennedy Center/Alvin Ailey tickets. WILL CALL Tickets will be available for pick up from the Kennedy Center's Main Box Office in the Hall of States, on the Foyer level; EFFECTIVE Tuesday, February 6 up until SHOWTIME. Box Office Hours are: Monday – Saturday, 10:00am – 9:00pm. Parking is FREE during the business day and weekend days. Let the attendant know that you are going to "box officer services." Get your parking ticket stamped at the box office after you retrieve your Will Call tickets. Depending on what time you arrive, you may be required to pre-pay \$23.00 to the parking attendant. Hold onto the receipt to receive the money back when you exit the garage. The validation stamp is valid for 1 hour after you enter the parking lot. Give the box office your first and last name. Your association with Alfred Street Baptist Church is not relevant to them. You do NOT need to show the Eventbrite printout. You will receive a Kennedy Center envelope with your official Kennedy Center tickets. The name on the Kennedy Center envelope is exactly as it was entered in the Eventbrite system when you purchased your tickets.

SEAT ASSIGNMENTS:

Alfred Street Baptist Church will assign ALL seats. The Kennedy Center did not assign ANY seats. For each section, seats were assigned based on the order in which the tickets were purchased. Please note: seats in some sections of the theater are not consecutively numbered. This means that two seats next to each other may not have ticket numbers that are in order or consecutive. If you purchased more than one ticket, you were assigned seats that are next to each other. Please DO NOT BE ALARMED if the numbers on your tickets are not consecutive. For example, if you purchased 2 tickets, your envelope may contain two tickets that are numbered: Section TR2, Row B, Seat 101 and Seat 103. Seats 101 and 103 are next to each other although they are not consecutively numbered. Similarly, you may have tickets that are numbered Section Orch, Row CC, Seat 2 and Seat 4. Seats 2 and 4 are next to each other although they are not consecutively numbered.

ACCESSIBILITY:

Every level of the theater is fully accessible. Ushers will take walkers, canes and wheelchairs and store them. If someone in a wheelchair is not comfortable transferring to a seat, then mark "Yes" that you need to reserve a wheelchair accessible seat on the registration form. The theater allows you to have up to 3 people sit with you. Wheelchair accessible seats are available on first come first served basis. There are a limited number of seats. If you select "Yes" you need to reserve a wheelchair accessible seat, it does NOT mean the seat is guaranteed. The church will follow-up with you. Wheelchair accessible tickets will be given out on a first some first serve basis. It is better to do this in advance of the show while the wheelchair accessible seats are still available.

LOST TICKET:

If you pick up your ticket early and misplace it or accidentally put it in the washing machine, plan to arrive to the Kennedy Center Box Office early to pick up a reprinted ticket. The church maintained a list of each ticket number assigned to each purchaser. The Kennedy Center will have this list. Give your first and last name to receive your ticket. If a ticket is reprinted, it will have "Reprint" stamped on it and the original ticket is automatically invalidated. You will have to return to Will Call to pick up the reprinted ticket. See arrival information below.

ARRIVAL FOR PERFORMANCE & DOORS OPEN

Plan to allow enough time to get to the Kennedy Center, park, take the elevator/escalators/stairs, and enter the theater. Other events are going on where upwards of 3,000 – 5,000 additional people will be in the building. The Kennedy Center has a gift ship, which will have Alvin Ailey memorabilia, as well as the Roof Top Terrace restaurant for dinner from 5pm – 8pm. Reservations are strongly recommended. The KC Café is also an option for lunch and dinner served daily from 11:30am to 8:00pm. Check the Kennedy Center website for more information. Theater doors open 30 minutes prior to each show. If you arrive after the performance starts, YOU WILL NOT BE SEATED. You will be held outside of the theater and asked to watch the performance on monitors. You will be seated at intermission. There are no seating breaks after the performance starts. If you plan to pick up tickets at Will Call shortly before the performance, please allow yourself extra time. If you're in line to pick up will call tickets and the performance starts, YOU WILL NOT BE SEATED.

RUN TIMES

The performances are approximately 2 hours with two fifteen minute intermissions.
